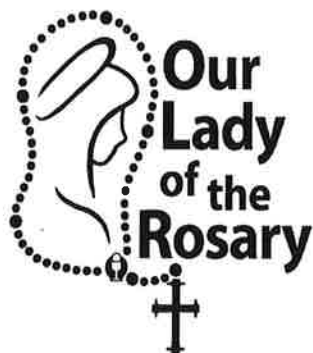


Welcome to the First Sunday of Advent,
