The most obvious example of God's merciful love was shown to us in the Paschal Mystery of Christ. Not only do we rejoice in this eternal victory, we also rejoice that, through our faith and participation in the sacraments, we can share in Christ's triumph as God extends his salvific mercy toward us. The Jubilee of Mercy reminds us that God "delights in mercy" (Mi.7:18), and so should we!
