

This year we celebrate the Feast of the Epiphany, also known as Three Kings' Day on January 3, 2021. Traditionally, the Epiphany is celebrated on January 6 (twelve days after Christmas). In the United States Diocese, the feast has been moved to Sunday between January 2 and January 8. The word "Epiphany" comes from the Greek and means "manifestation from above" commemorating the visit of the Magi to the Christ Child soon after His birth and celebrates His physical manifestation to the Gentiles.

Marking doorways or front porch steps with blessed chalk is a centuries-old Epiphany custom and a fun, visible way to dedicate your home and the New Year to God.

The inscription we make this year is:

$$20 + C + M + B + 21$$



The "20" and "20" stand for the current year (2021). The plus signs represent the Cross of Christ. The CMB are the first initials of the traditional names given to the Magi (Caspar, Melchior and Balthasar). They also abbreviate the Latin words *Christus mansionem benedicat* – "May Christ bless this dwelling."


