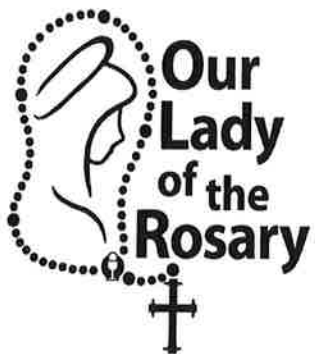


Welcome to the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time January 23, 2022

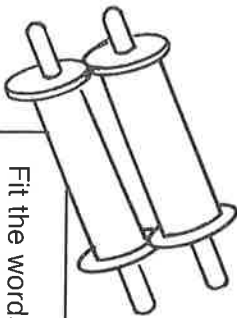
Jesus Returns to Nazareth

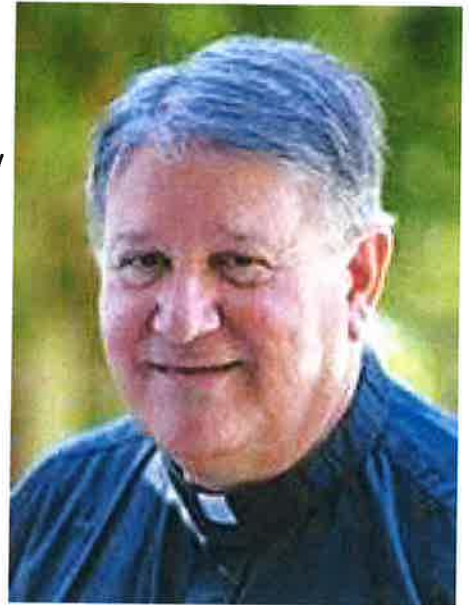
