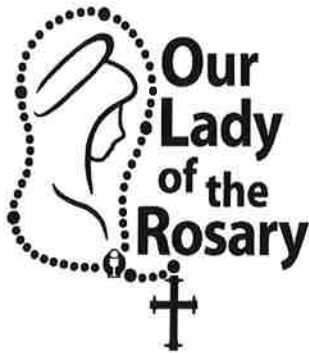


Welcome to the Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time January 30, 2022

Candlemas is a Catholic feast day that happens every year on February 2. In Jewish tradition at the time, a baby boy was to be presented at the temple 40 days after he was born to be dedicated to God, so Candlemas is 40 days after Christmas morning. This day used to be known as the "purification of Mary", as mothers were purified at the temple that day from having their baby. Bring your candle for a special blessing at this 8am Mass on Feb. 2nd.

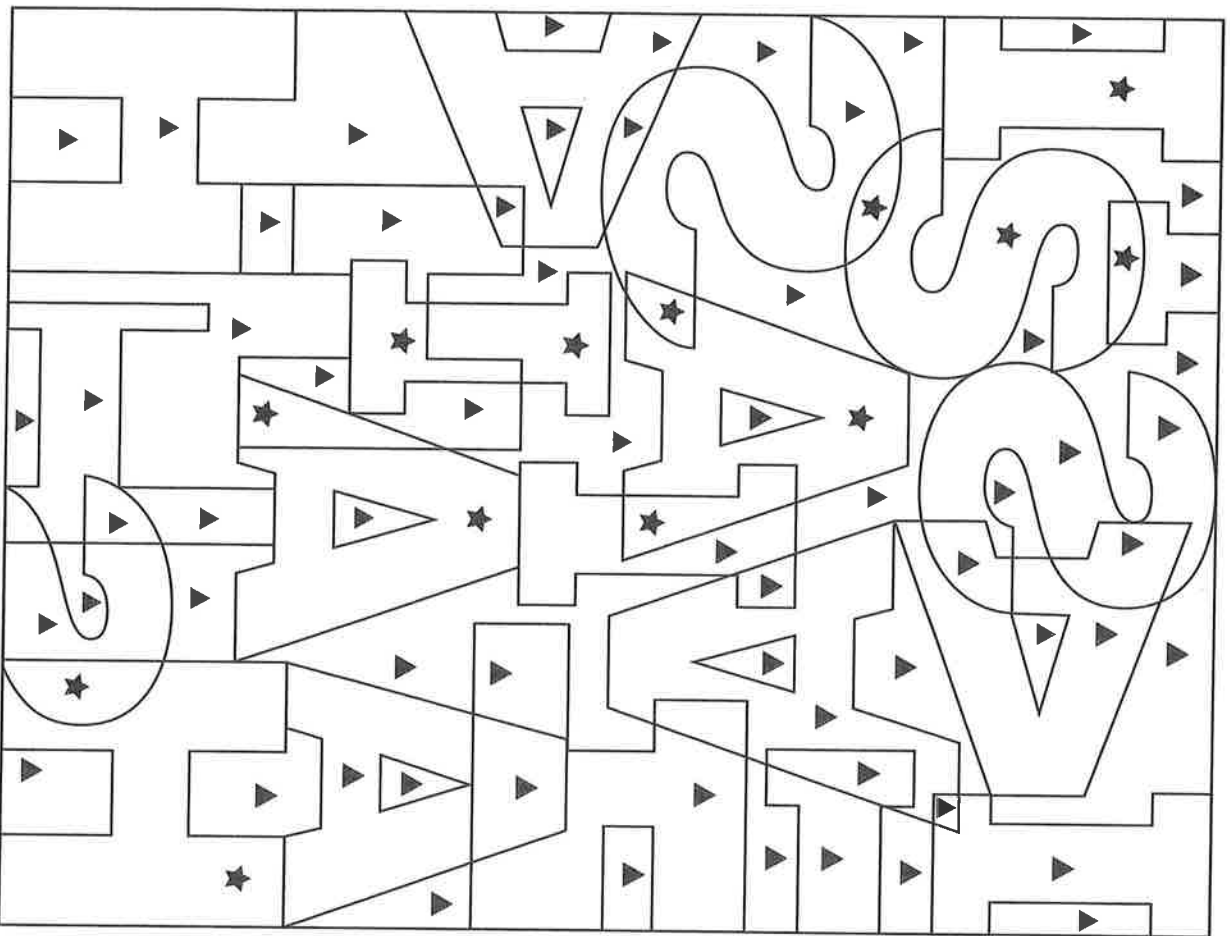
