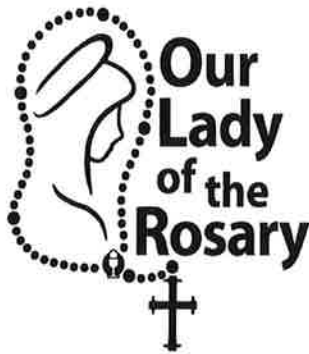


Welcome to the Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time February 13, 2022

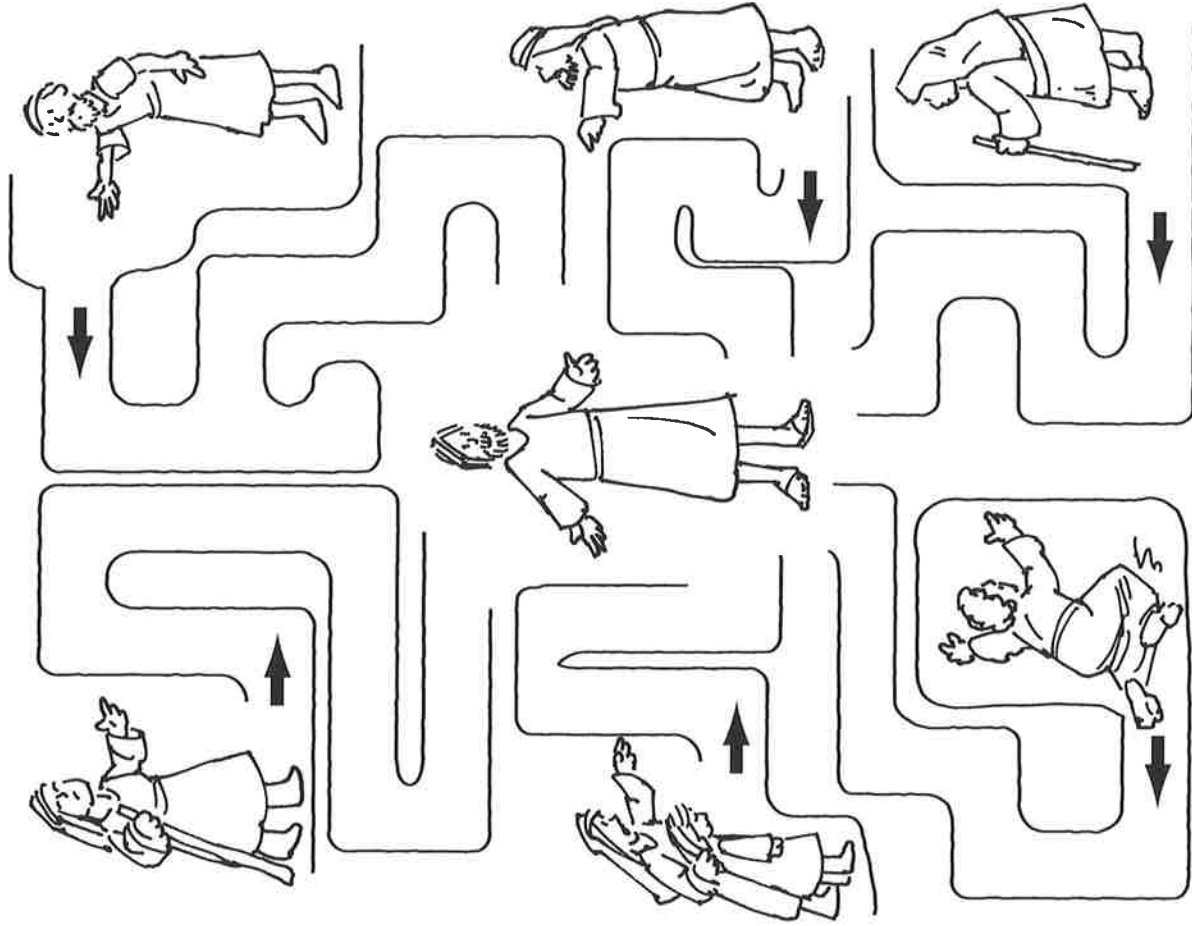
