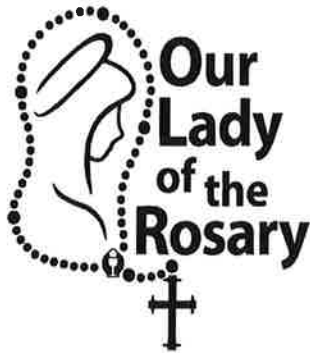


Welcome to the Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time February 27, 2022

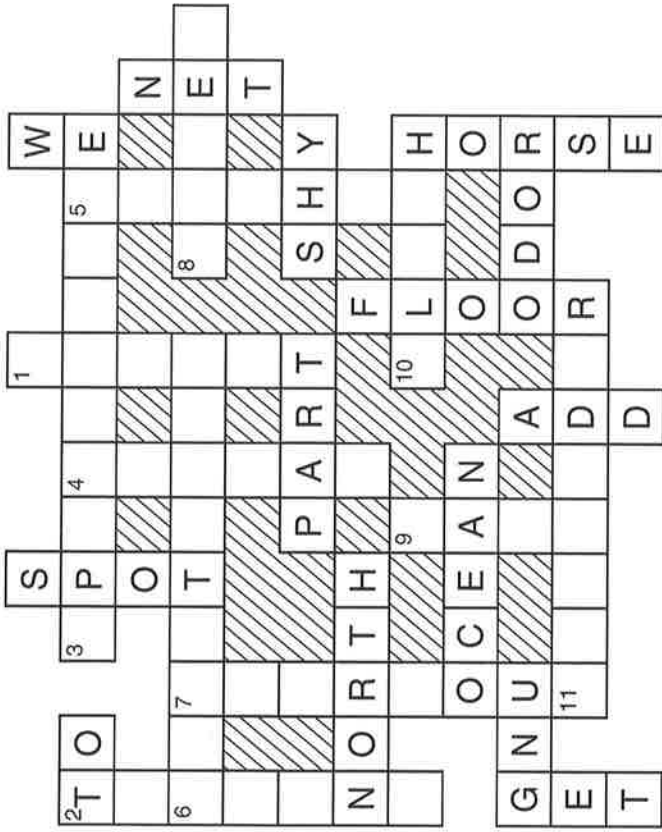

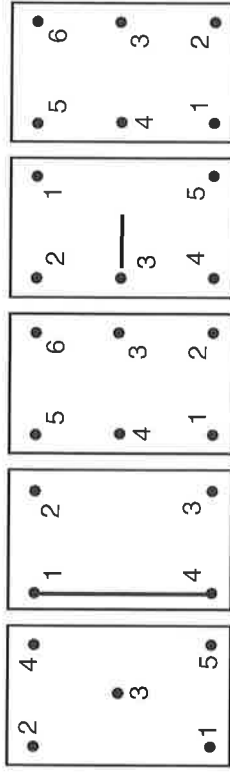
