Children's Liturgy of the Word at Home:

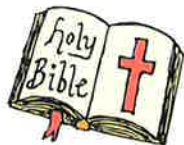

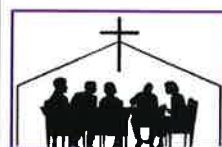

This office will be home to admin staff as well as several key programs such as the prescription assistance program, additional reentry services, and a future a classroom for educating volunteers, staff, and the community!

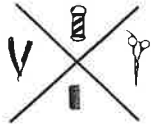
