FEDERAL CORONAVIRUS AID FOR EMERGENCY RENTAL ASSISTANCE



Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP)

While waiting for the program to come online, households should review the following.

To be eligible for the ERAP program:

1. The household must be a resident of Ada County, Idaho;
2. The household must have an income that does NOT exceed 80% Area Median Income;

Household Size	1 person	2 person	3 person	4 person	5 person	6 person	7 person	8 person
Income Limit	\$41,900	\$47,900	\$53,900	\$59,850	\$64,650	\$69,450	\$74,250	\$79,050

3. The family must have a COVID-19 related economic impact such as loss of job, reduced hours, reduced tips, or increased childcare or medical expenses;
4. The family must have an obligation to pay rent (lease agreement).

Dependent on funding availability, the program can provide funding for:

1. Past due rent
2. Past due utilities
3. Future rent & utilities in three month increments with recertification of eligibility every 90 days

While waiting for the program to come online households should gather the following required documentation:

1. Copy of the lease agreement and/or lease amendments;
2. Copy of an eviction notice or demands for payment;
3. Copy of utility bill (if requesting utility assistance);
4. Documentation of income (60 days check stubs, unemployment statement, child support printout, W2s and 1099s from 2020, social security award letters, etc);
5. Contact information for the landlord;
6. Documentation of the COVID-19 related economic impact (unemployment statement, termination letter, letter from employer regarding reduced hours, sufficient check stubs to document reduced hours, remote school documentation coupled with childcare statement, medical bills for COVID-19 related illness etc).

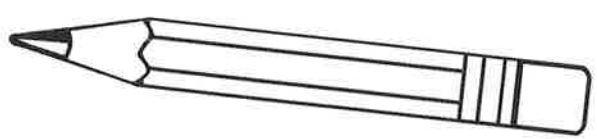
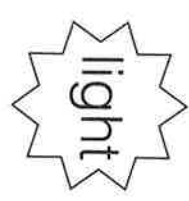
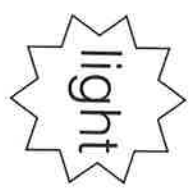








FEDERAL CORONAVIRUS AID FOR EMERGENCY RENTAL ASSISTANCE

- 1.0 \$175.7 million in federal coronavirus aid for emergency rental assistance
- 2.0 The money is for assistance with **rent and utilities** for Idaho renters impacted by the COVID-19 financial hardship and earn less than **80% of the area median income**
 - **See Attachment** Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP)
- 3.0 **Eligible renters could receive up to 12 months of assistance,**
 - They'd have to "re-certify" their eligibility every three months.
- 4.0 **APPLICATION!!!** - Idaho Housing & Finance Association will administer the program
