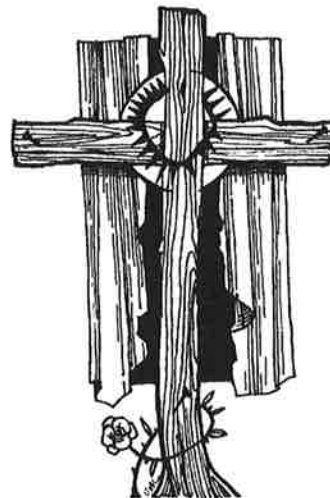

We attend Good Friday services to pray and meditate on Christ's passion. We venerate His Holy Cross. At the Great Vigil of Easter, the service begins with the kindling of a new fire – the light of Christ breaking into the darkness of our world. We will baptize new Christians and commit ourselves anew to be people of Christ's resurrection. We will celebrate that resurrection in the first Eucharist of Easter.
