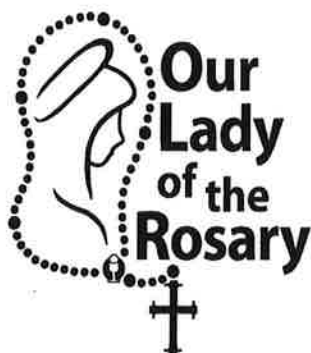

Just a Reminder!

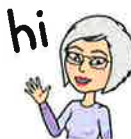
Sacred Heart and Our Lady of the Rosary supply the non-perishable food items for our Food Pantry located on Overland Road here in Boise.

PARISH COUNCIL NOMINATIONS TODAY!

The twelve-member Parish Council serves as advisors to the pastor and parish administrator in all matters pertaining to the spiritual, educational and community affairs in the parish. Each year four members complete their three-year term, and four new members join.

Election Process:

- The 6 to 10 parishioners with the most nominations are contacted to confirm nomination
- Confirmed nominees will appear on the ballot
- Elections will be held at the April 2 / April 3 Masses and available online thru April 8
- The 3 nominees receiving the most votes will assume a three-year term
- Election results will be announced April 23 / April 24

A Parish Council nominee should:

- Be a member in good standing with our Parish and the Roman Catholic Church
- Be willing to get involved in parish council activities and serve our parish
- Be able to make decisions that affect parish life
- Have a good and strong personal relationship with Jesus Christ
- Regularly attend mass
- Be a junior in high school or older

Nominees should be prepared to:

- Attend a monthly meeting and actively participate
- Serve a three-year term
- Serve as a liaison of communication for parish organizations and members
