Divine Mercy on Sunday, April 8 at 3pm (the Hour of Great Mercy). In a world where earthly things are preferred above our love of God and our desire to please Him, we need to beg God for His mercy for ourselves, our families and our world. Jesus told St. Faustina: "On that day, the very depths of My tender Mercy are open. I will pour out a whole ocean of graces upon souls who will approach the Fount of My Mercy." Therefore, to ensure that the faithful would observe this day with intense devotion, on June 13, 2002, Pope St. John Paul II established that Divine Mercy Sunday be enriched by a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions – receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation (beforehand), Eucharistic Communion (on that day) and prayers for the intentions of the Holy Father. All are welcome to join us for Eucharistic Exposition, Benediction and singing the Divine Mercy Chaplet beginning at 3pm in the church.
