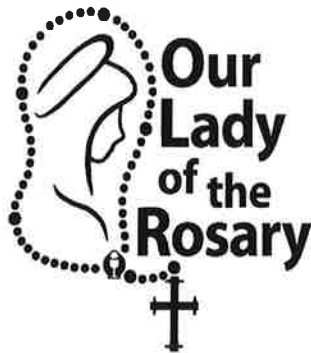


Welcome to the Fourth Sunday of Lent March 27, 2022
