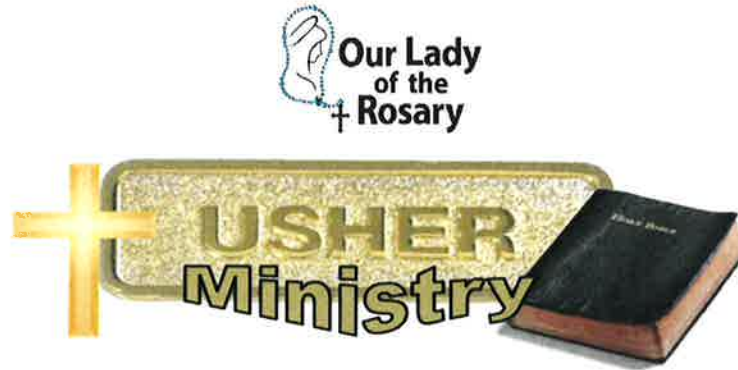

NEW! OLR Ushers & Greeters Ministry

At Our Lady of the Rosary, we value the opportunity to serve the Lord and consider it a privilege to be part of His ministry. We believe first and foremost that the purpose of being in ministry is to honor God by serving His people with the gifts and talents He has given us. With the privilege of serving His people comes the responsibility to live a life that reflects a sincere faith and a pursuit of holiness. We are now looking for individuals for this new ministry here at OLR. We are looking for 2-3 Ushers for each of our Masses.

When we serve at church in our ministries, we're not "just" a volunteer. We're given responsibilities and expectations beyond performing basic tasks.

Here are the responsibilities of ushers before, during, and after our services.

- Before Mass starts, the ushers will act as doorkeepers, greeting each person with a smile. They are also available to answer visitors' questions and extend extra help in seating those who need assistance. The ushers are also responsible to select gift bearers for the Offertory.
- Ushers also help with Communion. Ushers have a goal of minimizing distractions during the music and Homily. Ushers stand ready to assist anyone in the congregation who might need help, to aid latecomers in finding a seat, and to inform those in the sanctuary of any urgent matters.
- Ushers are well-versed in emergency procedures. In case of an emergency, the ushers will take the lead in getting people to safety in an orderly manner.
- After the service, ushers will again be at the door to greet the congregation as they leave and provide assistance as needed. After Mass, ushers will help sanitize the church.

Please keep in mind, that ushers should practice the qualities that Christ displayed:

Love, Joy, Peace, Patience, Kindness, Faithfulness, Gentleness, Self-Control
