**Gospel: John 11:1-45**

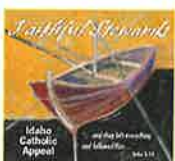


- ◆ **Adult:** Have you ever been too willing to "cast the first stone" when you disapprove of someone's behavior? How can you resist these feelings?
