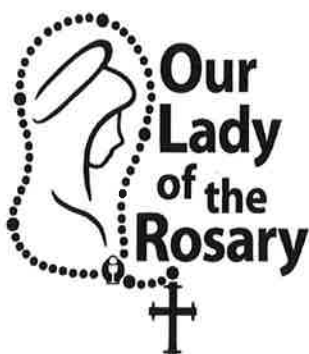

Our Lady of the Rosary Church will be celebrating the Feast of Divine Mercy on Sunday, April 24 at 3pm (the Hour of Great Mercy). In a world where earthly things are preferred above our love of God and our desire to please Him, we need to beg God for His mercy for ourselves, our families and our world. Jesus told St. Faustina: "On that day, the very depths of My tender Mercy are open. I will pour out a whole ocean of graces upon souls who will approach the Fount of My Mercy." Therefore, to ensure that the faithful would observe this day with intense devotion, on June 13, 2002, Pope St. John Paul II established that Divine Mercy Sunday be enriched by a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions – receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation (beforehand), Eucharistic Communion (on that day) and prayers for the intentions of the Holy Father. All are welcome to join us for Eucharistic Exposition, Benediction and singing the Divine Mercy Chaplet beginning at 3pm in the church.

## OLR's Weekly Mass Etiquette: Things To Do And Not Do In Mass!

- ◆ **Please be quiet while in church.** Once you enter the sanctuary - it is not the time or place to visit with those around you. If you must talk do so as quietly and briefly as possible. Remember that your conversation might be disturbing someone who is in prayer, which is much more important. Sssshhhhhhh!
- ◆ **Prayer after Mass,** if you feel called to do so. It is a good custom, though not required, to offer a prayer of thanksgiving after Mass is over.
- ◆ **Leave quietly.** We encourage you to visit with others, but only after you are outside of the main sanctuary of the church so you won't disturb others who want to stay and pray. So, please leave quietly and then have then visit afterward.
