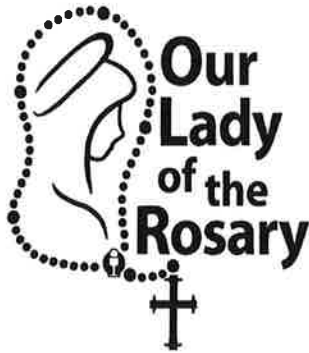

Marymount Hermitage

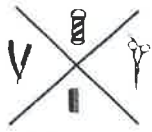
Hermit Sisters of Mary

Things To Do And Not Do In Mass!

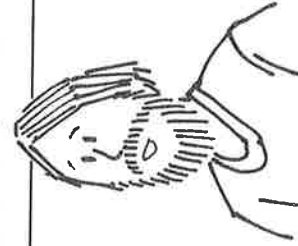
- ◆ **Please be quiet while in church.** Once you enter the sanctuary - it is not the time or place to visit with those around you. If you must talk do so as quietly and briefly as possible. Remember that your conversation might be disturbing someone who is in prayer, which is much more important. *Sssshhhhhhhh!*
- ◆ **Prayer after Mass,** if you feel called to do so. It is a good custom, though not required, to offer a prayer of thanksgiving after Mass is over.
- ◆ **Leave quietly.** We encourage you to visit with others, but only after you are outside of the main sanctuary of the church so you won't disturb others who want to stay and pray. So, please leave quietly and then have then visit afterward.
