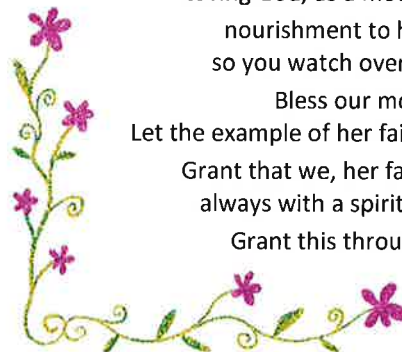

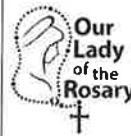
Bishop Peter concluded his update to the Parishes:
