In the time between the ascension and the second coming, then, our task is to recognize Christ all around us, especially in the poor; honoring them is indeed a key part of our Gospel mission.

Jesus commissioned followers to proclaim the Good News and to follow him, on our earthly journey and to our heavenly destination. He's far from gone! He is among us and in us. We are reflections of his presence in the world.
