Moments of Mercy

Saints of Mercy ~ Feed the Hungry: St. Louis IX (1214-1270) St. Louis' devout mother taught him to love God. As a king, he ruled France with mercy and showed his subjects how to be just. He had a special love for the poor and provided food for them. It was said that over a hundred poor people ate in his palace daily and the king often served them himself.

Give Drink to the Thirsty: St. Peter Claver (1581-1654) St. Peter Claver was sent for mission work in South America. He brought basic necessities, including drinks, to the slaves and nursed them back to health. He spoke to them about God and satisfied the thirst in their hearts.
