

Children's Liturgy of the Word: Next Sunday, we begin Ordinary Time with Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. We celebrate the mystery of the Holy Trinity: one God in three persons. A solemnity is a feast day in the Catholic Roman Rite liturgical calendar of the highest rank celebrating a mystery of faith such as the Trinity, an event in the life of Jesus, his mother Mary, or another important saint. The observance begins with the vigil on the evening before the actual date of the feast. Pray as you read and discuss the following Bible passages:

Reading I: Exodus 34:4b-6, 8-9

Psalm: Daniel 3:52, 53, 54, 55

Reading II: 2 Corinthians 13:11-13

Gospel: John 3:16-18
