Children's Liturgy of the Word: The second Sunday after Pentecost, we celebrate a second solemnity, which marks our return to Ordinary Time. Next Sunday, is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. At one time, this day was called *Corpus Christi*, Latin for “the Body of Christ.” In the most recent revision of the liturgy, the name for this day is expanded to be a more complete reflection of our Eucharistic theology

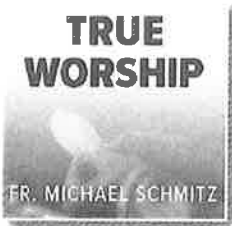

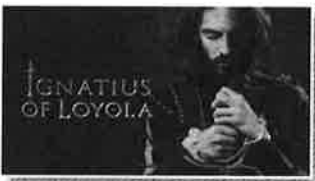
