Children learn about worship and liturgical behavior by copying you.

If you have to leave Mass with your child, feel free to do so, **but please come back.** As Jesus said, "Let the children come to me..." Remember that the way we welcome children in church directly affects the way they respond to the church, to God and to one another. Let them know that they are at home in His house of worship
