### The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)

The RCIA is the method by which adults receive the Catholic sacraments of initiation; Baptism, Confirmation, and the Eucharist. Those who have been validly baptized in another Christian denomination are not baptized again but are received into full communion with the Catholic Church through a profession of faith following catechesis. The sacraments of initiation are normally conferred during the Easter Vigil Mass. Our Lady of the Rosary typically begins preparation in early September. We meet on Tuesday evenings from 7:00pm to 8:30pm.
