Saints of Mercy ~ Clothe the Naked: St. Martin of Tours (316-397) St. Martin was the Bishop of Tours, France. As a young soldier, he met a poor shivering beggar who had little to wear. He cut off half of his cloak to cover the beggar. That night, he dreamt of Jesus wearing the same half portion of his cloak. St. Martin realized that what he did for the beggar, he was in fact doing for Jesus.

Shelter the Homeless: St. John Vianney (1786-1859) St. John Vianney was a holy parish priest in Ars, France. He started an orphanage, La Providence, to shelter homeless girls. They learned shills such as housekeeping and received advice for their spiritual life. St. John Vianney loved to visit them and he taught them about God. 
