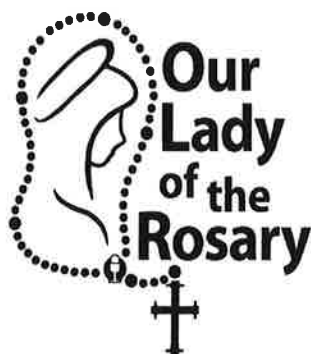


# Welcome to the 15<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Ordinary Time, July 11, 2021

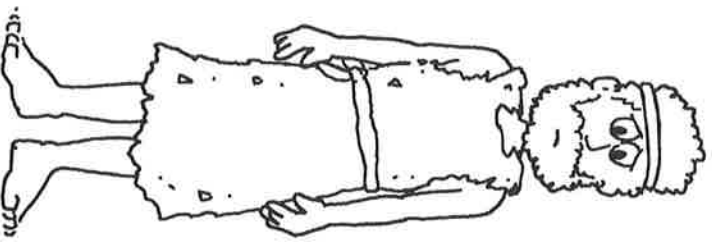
