Moments of Mercy ~Saints of Mercy ~

Visit the Sick: St. Vincent de Paul (1581-1660) Vincent was a priest in France who had a deep compassion for the sick. Once he was so deeply moved by a sick man's deathbed confession that he desired to bring God's love to those in need. He started groups to visit and care for the sick in every parish. He also encouraged a group of wealthy ladies to provide for the mission. Several hospitals to help the sick were founded. He also inspired a religious order to care for the sick.

St. Bernadette Soubirous Comfort the Afflicted: (1844-1879) St. Bernadette came from the village of Lourdes in France. When she was 14, she saw a vision of Mother Mary and miracles began to happen. She later left home to become a nun. Although life in the convent was difficult, she was always available to help others. Her compassionate ways were comforting to others, especially the sick. One day, she saw a homesick novice crying and consoled her. She told the novice that she was watering her vocation with her tears. The novice felt encouraged and stopped crying.
