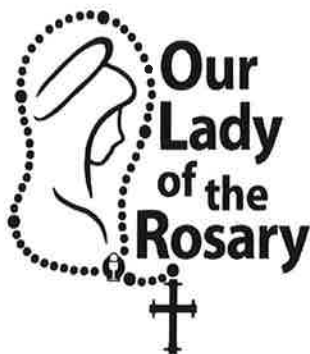


Welcome to the 17th Sunday of Ordinary Time, July 25, 2021

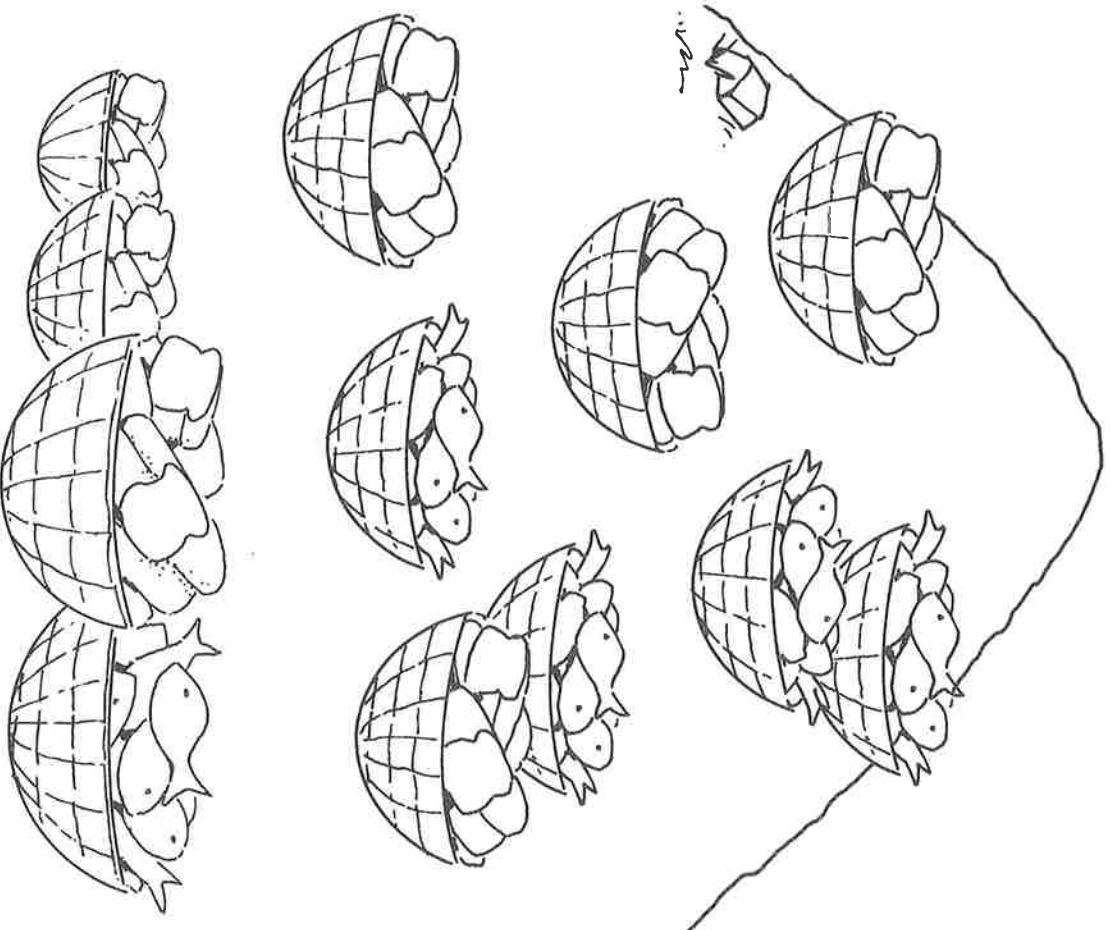

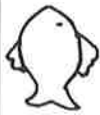
