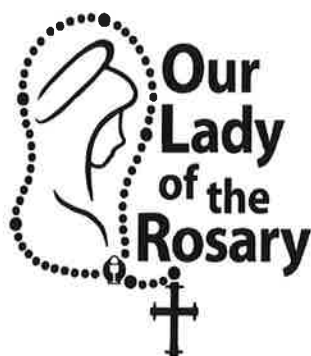


Welcome to the 24th Sunday in Ordinary Time, September 12, 2021
