ANGELS

The English word "angel" comes from the Greek angelos, which means "messenger." In the Hebrew Scriptures, with two exceptions, the Hebrew word for angel is malak and also means "messenger." Although "angel" nearly always applies to heavenly beings when used in the Bible, it occasionally applies to human messengers. The most significant angel is Gabriel, who appears to Daniel, Zachary and Mary. We celebrate the feast of the Archangels Michael, Gabriel and Raphael on September 29. On October 2 we celebrate the feast of our Guardian Angels, who watch over and safeguard all God's creatures. "No evil shall befall you, no affliction come near your tent, for God commands the angels to guard you in all your ways. With their hands they shall support you, lest you strike your foot against a stone" (Psalm 91:10–12).




