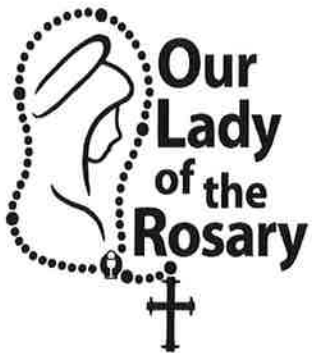


Welcome to the 29th Sunday in Ordinary Time, October 17, 2021
