Children's Liturgy of the Word: When we pray, we must remember to pray in humility and remember the need for God in our lives. If we are too full of ourselves, there is too little room for God's grace to work in us. Pray together as a family as you read and discuss the following Bible passages:

Twenty-Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Reading I: 2 Kings 5:14-171:2-3;2:2-4,

Reading II: 2 Timothy 2:8-13 Gospel: Luke 17:11-19



- Adult: This Gospel reading suggests that we approach God and each other with humility. What does this mean, in practical terms? How do we "humble" ourselves before God and man?
- Child: God knows when we are doing things just for show, and when they come from the goodness of our heart. When have you caught yourself doing something just to be more popular or liked? How does it feel to do something that you know is good and just?


