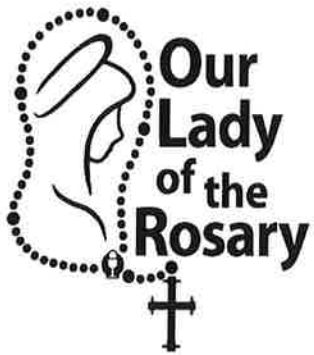


**Welcome to the 31<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time, October 31, 2021**

**November 25th** Thanksgiving Day Mass at 9:00AM. (Office closed at Noon on 24th, Closed 25th & 26th)

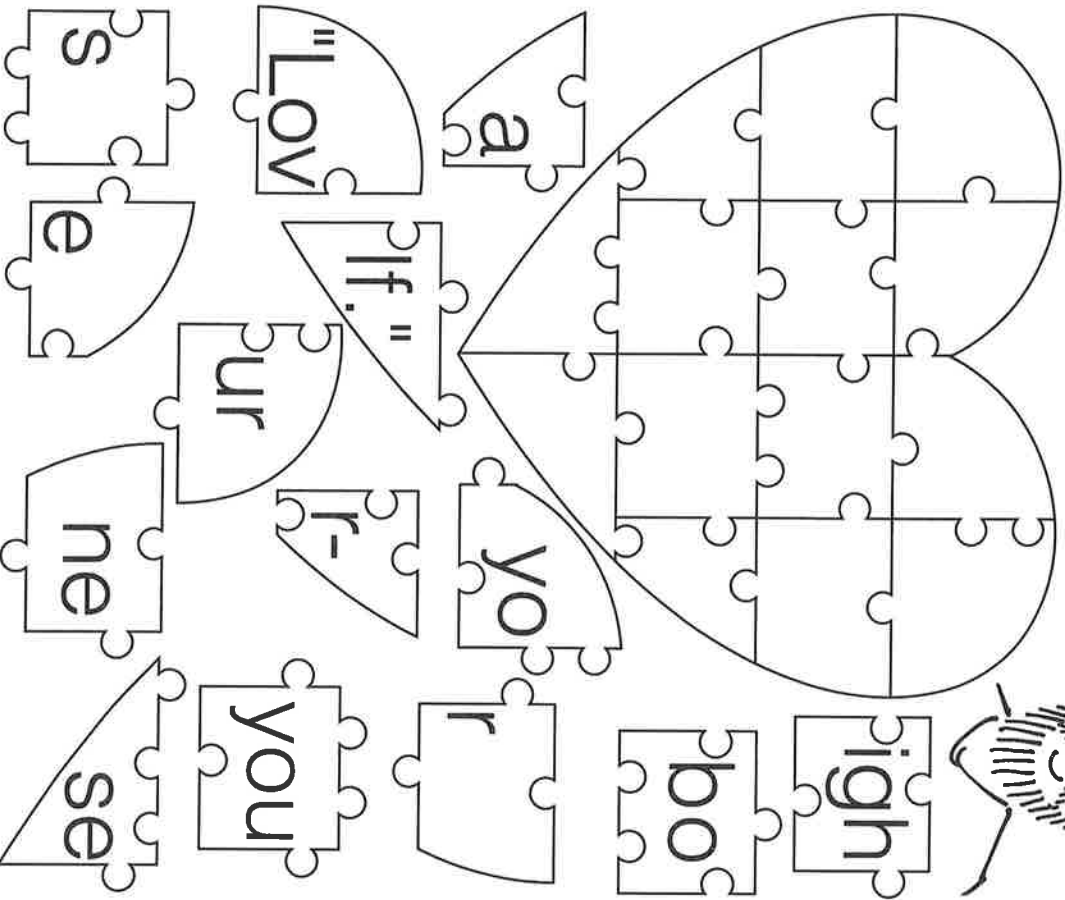
