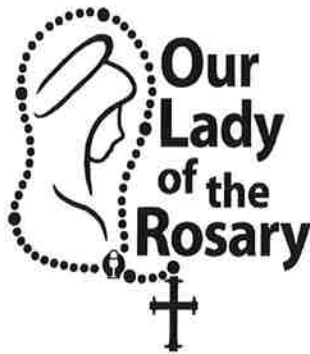


Welcome to the 33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time, November 14, 2021

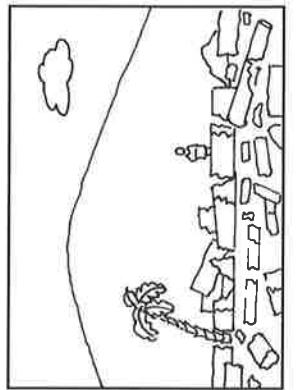
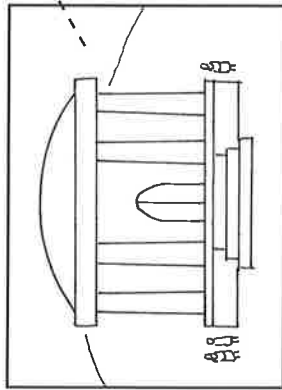
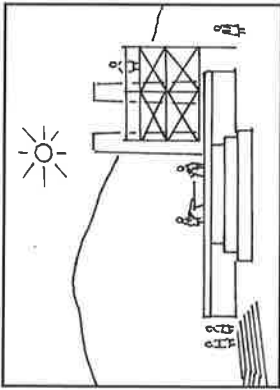
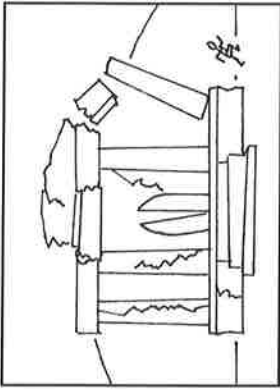
The Temple's Fate and Keeping Watch
