Bury the Dead: St. Teresa of Calcutta(1910-1997)

St. Teresa spent her life serving the poorest of the poor. She started a Home for the Dying for those who had nowhere to go. One day, she saw dying woman lying in the street badly eaten up by the rats. She carried the woman to the Home and helped her. She eventually brought many others the to the Home. They were loved and cared for until the last day of their lives and died with dignity.

Praying for the Living and the Dead: St. Pio of Pietrelcina (1887-1968) St. Pio was a Capuchin Priest from Italy. He was a very holy man with many spiritual gifts. He was able to see people's guardian angels and these angels presented their needs for St. Pio to pray for. There were also many people who visited and wrote to him for his intercessions. St. Pio was also able see the Holy Souls from Purgatory who sought his prayers. His prayers comforted the living and the dead greatly.
