

What we do

- Receive assistance calls from the SVdP help line and do home visits to assess needs.
- Assist with rent, utility and other emergency needs, providing clothing, furniture, and other household items through our thrift store voucher program. When we do a home visit, we also provide referrals to other agencies, information about our various programs, community suppers and prescription assistance.
- Sponsor the Annual Thanksgiving Food Box drive in November every year, which
 provides thousands of needy families with food for the holiday.
- Operate three thrift stores in Boise.
- Sponsor a re-entry program to help folks transition back into the community after incarceration.
- Participate in the community supper program and host a free dinner at our center on Overland four nights per week. We serve up to 100 dinners per night to needy folks and families.
- Operate a Food Pantry at our center on Overland. This is open to the public.
- We host a fabulously fun fundraiser event in June every year. These funds help finance our ministry.

The Society of St. Vincent de Paul is a Beatitude driven, Christ filled ministry.
