Faith Formation

- ◆ **May God bless all our families with a healthy and happy New Year!**
- ◆ **Religious Education classes resume Sunday, January 12 and Family Faith Formation on Wednesday, January 8.**
- ◆ **Christmas does not end on December 25.** It begins on Christmas Eve, continues through the Christmas Octave (8 days until January 1) and goes until the first Sunday of ordinary time which is January 12.
Celebrate these feast days during the Liturgical Season of Christmas
 - *December 29: The Feast of the Holy Family
 - *January 1: The Solemnity of the Blessed Virgin Mary, the Mother of God
 - *January 5: The Solemnity of Epiphany
 - *January 12: The Feast of the Baptism of the Lord
- ◆ **New Year's House Blessing:** Using chalk on the lintel over the door or making a sign to hang above your door, print 20+C+M+B+19 – These stand for the new year and the names of the Magi, Caspar, Melchior, and Balthazar. Some people say the letters CMB stand for Christus Mansionem Benedictat - Christ, bless this house. The + represent Jesus' sacrifice for us. Sprinkle Holy Water to bless the doorways of your home.

Children's Liturgy of the Word at Home: The feast of the Epiphany shares the story of the Magi who seek the child Jesus to pay Him homage and give Him gifts. The gifts of the Magi—gold, frankincense, and myrrh—have come to be understood as symbols of Christ's royalty, divinity, and eventual suffering and death.

Gospel: Matthew 2:1-12



- ◆ **Adult:** Take some time to reflect on the tradition of gift giving at Christmas. Think of the best gift you have received. What was it? What made it special? Was it the gift itself, the thought that went into it, or the person who gave it to you?
- ◆ **Child:** How does it feel when you are given presents? How do you feel when you give somebody a gift? What gift can you offer Jesus this Christmas?
