Catholic Corner

What is the significance of a candle in the Catholic faith, and why do we light them under pictures and statues of the Saints?

Candles are important in the Catholic faith because of what they signify; light in the darkness, the purifying nature of fire, and, in this case, presence. For example a lit candle next to a tabernacle lets us know that Christ, in the Eucharist, is present in the tabernacle. When we pray before pictures and statues of Saints, we are not praying TO them but asking them to pray WITH and FOR us. As we light a candle beneath the image of the Saint, the single, steady, and constant flame signifies out presence in the prayer we bring before God. It also reminds us that Christ will bring His light into every situation we bring before Him.

Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist
Bishops, Priests and Deacons are Ordinary Ministers of the Eucharist. Because of the size of our parish we are in need of extraordinary ministers of the Eucharist. These are practicing Catholics who assist the priest in distribution of the Eucharist to the faithful at Mass. The requirement is that the individual be a confirmed Catholic (having received the Sacrament of Confirmation), and have been adequately trained for this role.
