
Welcome to The Third Sunday of Easter

Where does the term "MASS" come from? "Mass is an English rendering of the Latin term "missa." In Latin the Mass ends with "Ite missa est," which translated into English means "Go, it is sent" the "it" being the Church. From the Latin word "missa" comes from the English word "dismiss." So "Mass" means "dismissal." The celebration takes its name from the sending forth that occurs at the end of every Mass!

Please be guiet while in church.

- Once you enter the sanctuary it is not the time or place to visit with those around you. If you must talk do so as quietly and briefly as possible. Remember that your conversation might be disturbing someone who is in prayer either before or after Mass.






